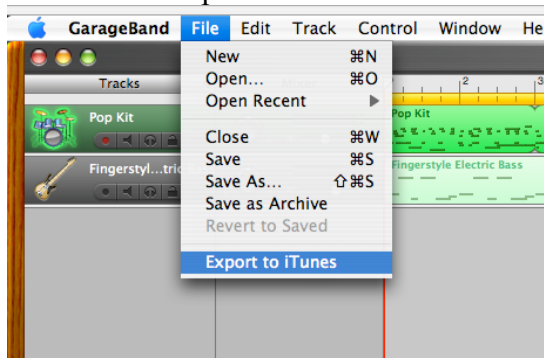
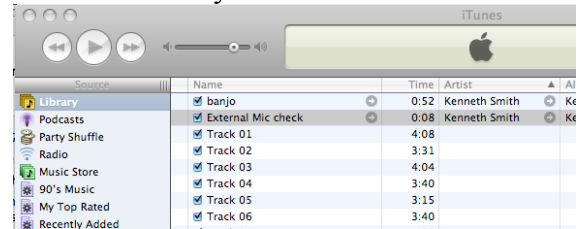


Exporting your GarageBand project to iTunes and converting to .mp3.

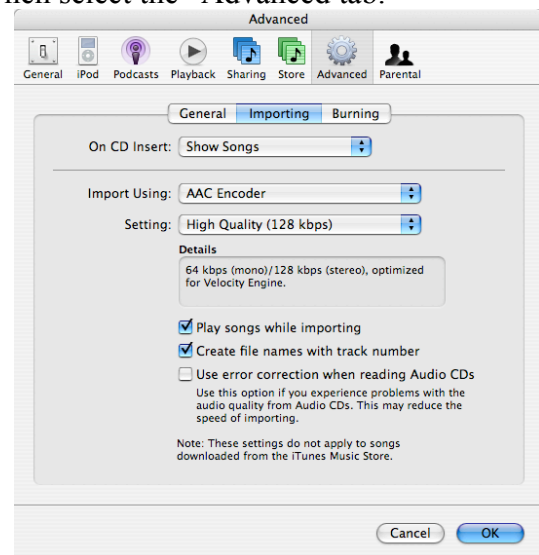
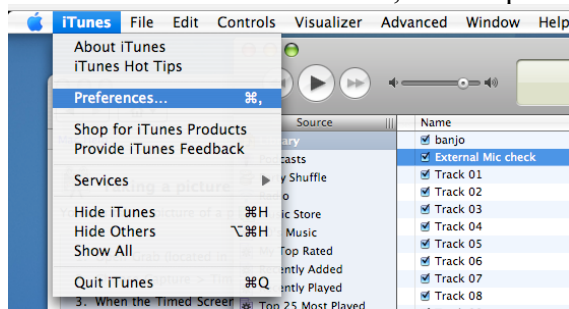
1. From the File menu in GarageBand, choose “Export to iTunes.”



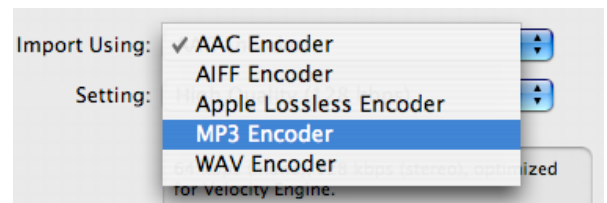
2. After iTunes has opened you will see the title of your GarageBand file in the iTunes library.



3. From the iTunes File menu, choose preferences. Then select the “Advanced tab.”



4. Click on the “Import Using:” list box to see the options that you have for converting your audio file. Choose “MP3 Encoder.”



5. Select OK in the Preferences dialog box.
6. Convert the music file by highlighting the file in the library, from the Advanced menu, choose “Convert to MP3”
7. iTunes will now encode your file as an .mp3 type and begin playing the file.
8. To transfer this file to a disk. Drag the audio file from your iTunes library to the Desktop, or some other storage media mounted on your computer.
