- \*Baccalaureate writing courses must be taken at Western Michigan University, unless approved by the School of Communication Faculty Advisor
- \*Courses approved as “Com credit” may be used as toward general electives toward graduation. They may also be used to fulfill a 1000-2000 level communication elective.
- \*Up to 6 total hours in any combination of 3980/4990 may be used toward a major and up to 3 hours of 3980/4990 may be used toward a minor
- \*Students may take up to 6 hours each of COM 3050 & COM 4800 credit **provided the topics are different**
