

## COMMUNICATION MINOR (CMLN) – 18 hours

### Non-teaching Minor

(for students with a catalog year beginning fall 2004 – su II 2009)

<b>Section A: Required Courses</b> .....	12 hours
COM 1040: Public Speaking .....	3
COM 1700: Interpersonal Communication I .....	3
COM 2000: Human Communication Theory .....	3
COM 2400: Introduction to Media and Telecommunications .....	3

**Section B: Communication Electives** ..... 6 hours

COM electives are any courses offered by the School of Communication which are not required for the Com minor (those in section A). If you meet the course pre-requisites you may be eligible to register for the course.

- This minor may not be taken by students majoring in any other area of communication.
- Minors should recognize that registration in some communication courses may be limited to declared majors for whom those courses are required.
- Grade requirement: A minimum grade of “C” is required in all courses to be applied toward a minor.
- The School prohibits students from taking a class more than twice for credit.
- COM 3050/Com 4800 may be taken twice for credit, providing the topics are different.
- Up to 6 credits of COM 4990/COM 3980 may be used as electives in the minor.
