

## SECONDARY EDUCATION MINOR IN COMMUNICATION (CMSN)

21 hours

(for students with a catalog year effective fall 2004 – summer II 2009)

This minor is restricted to PED/SED students majoring in **English** who have an overall GPA of 2.50.

COM 1040: Public Speaking .....	3
COM 1700: Interpersonal Communication I .....	3
COM 2000: Human Communication Theory .....	3
COM 3320: Group Problem Solving .....	3
<i>Prerequisites: "C" or better in COM 1700, COM 2000</i>	
COM 3340: Argumentation and Debate .....	3
<i>Prerequisites: declared CMSN</i>	
COM 5600: Teaching Communication .....	3
<i>Prerequisites: declared CMSN; "C" or better in COM 1040, 1700, 2000; junior or senior</i>	
<b>Section B: Communication Electives</b> .....	3 hours

Three hours of electives in Communication selected from upper-level (3000) or higher courses in the school. **Recommended courses are: Com 3590, Com 4430, Com 4440 or Com 4450**

- All course prerequisites must be met to enroll in upper-level courses. A course and its prerequisites cannot be taken at the same time.
- Grade requirement: A minimum grade of "C" is required in all courses to be applied toward the minor.
- The School prohibits students from taking a class more than twice for credit.
- It is recommended that students electing this minor become actively involved in university and secondary education extracurricular activities in speech and communication.
- Minors should recognize that registration in some communication elective courses may be limited to declared majors for whom those courses are required.
- Secondary Communication Education minors at WMU earn an endorsement in Speech. You must pass the MTTC Test # 04 (Speech).
